Nebraska Tops Poll

NASHVILLE—

The University of Nebraska is the National Ten Pin Coaches Association's choice as the NCAA's No. 1 bowling team heading into the 201-15 season.

The Huskers, who finished as national runner-up last spring, had 11 of the 23 first place votes and 664 points to poll ahead of second place Arkansas State, who garnered four first place votes and 613 points.

Defending NCAA champion Sam Houston State was third with seven first place ballots (572 points), followed by Vanderbilt, which had the remaining first place vote and 542 points.

Perennial power programs Maryland-Eastern Shore was fifth (524), Central Missouri sixth (456) and Fairleigh Dickinson seventh (444). Wisconsin-Whitewater (360), Stephen F. Austin (315) and St. Francis (Pa.) (272) rounded out the Top 10.

The next five schools are Sacred Heart (182), Kutztown (176), North Carolina A&T (161), LIU Brooklyn (134), and Valparaiso (121).

Rounding out the final five teams in the poll are Mckendree (110), Saint Francis College (65), Alabama State (46), Delaware State (43), and Monmouth (29).

Point system:

NTCA voters rank the top 20 teams on their ballot. Each position has a designated point value, ranging from 32 points for first place and one point for twentieth place. Teams are ranked using the adjusted total point standings, after the highest and lowest votes are dropped. The specific point values follow:

1st place = 32 points, 2nd = 29, 3rd = 27, 4th = 25, 5th = 23, 6th = 21, 7th = 19, 8th = 17, 9th = 15, 10th = 13, 11th = 11, 12th = 9, 13th = 8, 14th = 7, 15th = 6, 16th = 5, 17th = 4, 18th = 3, 19th = 2, 20th = 1.
