Arkansas State Holds Poll Lead
NASHVILLE, TN---The same three NCAA bowling teams remained atop the latest poll by the National Ten Pin Coaches Association, which was released Thursday.
Arkansas State, Nebraska and Vanderbilt retained their positions while a number of newcomers were added to the second ten of the monthly poll.
The Red Wolves garnered 26 of the 31 first place votes despite not winning a tourney in January. ASU was third at its own Mid-Winter Classic and second at the Prairie View Invitational.
Nebraska got three first-place votes after winning the Prairie View event and placing seventh at the Mid-Winter while Vanderbilt's finishes of fourth at the Mid-Winter, second at Kutztown and third at Prairie View helped earn the remaining two first-place nods. San Houston State moved up a notch to fourth, exchanging places with Central Missouri. McKendree was the biggest mover in the Top 10, shooting up from ninth into sixth, followed by Wisconsin-Whitewater, Stephen F. Austin, Fairleigh Dickinson and North Carolina A \& T.
The second 10 had a revised look with Maryland-Eastern Shore slipping from $10^{\text {th }}$ into $13^{\text {th }}$ while Adelphi, Sacred Heart, Prairie View, Elmhurst and Bethune-Cookman earned new places in the poll.

    NTCA voters rank the top 20 teams on their ballot. Each position has a designated point value, ranging from 32 points for first place and one point for twentieth place. Teams are ranked using the adjusted total point standings, after the highest and lowest votes are dropped. The specific point values follow: 1 st place $=40$ points, $2 n d=37,3 r d=35,4 t h=33,5$ th $=31,6$ th $=29,7$ th $=31=27,8$ th $=25,9$ th $=23,10$ th $=21,11$ th $=19$, $12 t h=17,13 t h=15,14 t h=13,15 t h=11,16 t h=10,17 t h=9,18 t h=8,19 t h=7,20 t h=6,21^{s^{t}}=5,22^{\text {nd }}=4,23^{r d}=3,24^{t^{t h}}=2,25^{t h}=1$.
