Nebraska Remains No. 1 Ranking in February Poll

WHITEWATER, WI. --- University of Nebraska received 26 first place votes, to hold on to their No. 1 ranking in the National Tenpin Coaches Association February Poll. The Cornhuskers went 12-1 at the Mid-Winter Classic and have improved their overall season record to 45-6. No. 2 McKendree University started their spring semester off with a bang, winning the Mid-Winter Classic and the Kutztown Invitational. The Bearcats picked up 17 first place votes, and have improved their overall record to 49-13.

Arkansas State University (45-20), Vanderbilt University (51-26), and Sam Houston State University (52-24) keep the same ranking from the Preseason and December Polls. Vanderbilt has started to build momentum, as the Commodores finished third at the Mid-Winter Classic and second at the Kutztown Invitational.

The Hornets of Delaware State University come in at No. 6, with a record of 48-16. Delaware State posted another top five finish at the Kutztown Invitational. The Ladyjacks of Stephen F. Austin State University (50-27) remain No. 7, and the University of Maryland Eastern Shore (44-22) rounds out the top 8.

Other top 10 teams include, Tulane University (39-25) and Fairleigh Dickinson University (34-23). Tulane continues to impress voters, after posting back to back top five finishes at the Midwinter Classic and Kutztown Invitational.

[^0]:    Point system: NTCA submitted ballots rank the top 25 programs in the sport of NCAA bowling. Each position has a designated point value, ranging from 40 points for first place and one point for twenty-fifth place. To be ranked teams need to equal or surpass the minimum vote criteria, which is one vote for every eight ballots submitted. The actual ranking position is determined by using the adjusted point standings, which lists in priority order the total points a school has accumulated after the highest and lowest votes are dropped. The specific point values follow: 1 st place $=40$ points, 2nd $=37,3$ rd $=35,4$ th $=33,5$ th $=31,6$ th $=29,7$ th $=27,8$ th $=25,9$ th $=23,10$ th $=21,11$ th $=19,12$ th $=17,13$ th $=15,14$ th $=13$, 15 th $=11,16$ th $=10,17$ th $=9,18$ th $=8,19$ th $=7,20$ th $=6,21$ st $=5,22$ nd $=4,23$ rd $=3,24$ th $=2,25$ th $=1$.
