NEBRASKA TOPS FINAL NTCA POLL

NASHVILLE, TN---The Nebraska Cornhuskers topped the National Tenpin Coaches Association (NTCA) final poll of the year after winning the NCAA Championship earlier this month in North Kansas City.

The Huskers defeated Arkansas State in the title match to win their first national championship since 2015. They collected 31 of the 32 first place votes from the participating head coaches.

Arkansas State finished second in the polling with McKendree, a semi-finalist at the national championship, placing third and collecting the other first place vote.

Vanderbilt, which carried Nebraska into the tenth frame of the best-of-seven Baker matches at the championship, finished fourth, followed by Youngstown State, North Carolina A&T, Sam Houston, Fairleigh Dickinson, Louisiana Tech and Sacred Heart to round out the top 10.

<u>Point system:</u> NTCA submitted ballots rank the top 25 programs in the sport of NCAA bowling. Each position has a designated point value, ranging from 40 points for first place and one point for twenty-fifth place. To be ranked teams need to equal or surpass the minimum vote criteria, which is one vote for every eight ballots submitted. The actual ranking position is determined by using the adjusted point standings, which lists in priority order the total points a school has accumulated after the highest and lowest votes are dropped. The specific point values follow: 1st place = 40 points, 2nd =37, 3rd =35, 4th =33, 5th =31, 6th =29, 7th =27, 8th =25, 9th =23, 10th =21, 11th =19, 12th =17, 13th =15, 14th =13, 15th =11, 16th =10, 17th =9, 18th =8, 19th =7, 20th =6, 21st =5, 22nd =4, 23rd =3, 24th =2, 25th =1.
