McKendree Bearcats #1 in NTCA Poll

NACOGDOCHES, TX---After months of fluctuations, there was very little movement in the February poll of National Ten Pin Coaches Association as the nation's collegiate bowling coaches appear to have settled in on who they think are the NCAA's top teams.

McKendree, Nebraska, Sam Houston State and Vanderbilt maintained their top-four poll status in the newest polling, although Nebraska and Sam Houston swapped spots in the standings.

The McKendree Bearkats stayed at No. 1, earning 24 of the 42 first-place votes by NTCA member coaches. McKendree won the five-team Columbia 300 Saints Invitational, was second at Nebraska's Big Red Invite and overcame a ninth place finish as the Mid-Winter Classic to maintain its hold at the top.

Nebraska, with 16 first-place votes, slid up a notch into second place with a strong month in which it won the Mid-Winter Classic and its own Big Red Invite and finished second at the Columbia 300 Saints Invitational. The two championships were the Huskers fifth of the season.

Sam Houston State, getting two first place votes, slipped to third after a pair of fourth place finishes at the Lady Techsters and Stallings tournaments. The Bearkats contended with an assortment of injuries during the month.

Vanderbilt held onto fourth after placing seventh at the Lady Techsters but rebounding to win the Stallings Invitational.

North Carolina A & T continued its strong season with a championship at Morgan State's James Brown Invitational, a second place at its own Stallings Invite and by ending its MEAC competition with the league's No. 1 seed heading into the conference tournament.

Arkansas State, Louisiana Tech, Stephen F. Austin, Youngstown State and Duquesne round out the Top 10.

There was also very little movement among the second 10 teams in the February poll. Mount St. Mary's held down 11th, followed by Maryville (St. Louis), Fairleigh Dickinson, Delaware State, Tulane, Sacred Heart, Maryland-Eastern Shore, Wisconsin-Whitewater, Morgan State and Long Island University.

Lewis, Lincoln Memorial, Central Missouri, Monmouth and Adelphi complete the Top 25. Teams will shift their focus to upcoming conference tournaments with the hopes of making the NCAA field, where regional and championship play begin in April.

NTCA voters rank the top 25 teams on their ballot. Each position has a designated point value, ranging from 40 points for first place and one point for twenty-fifth place. To be ranked teams need to equal or surpass the minimum vote criteria, which is one vote for every eight ballots submitted. The actual ranking position is determined by using the adjusted point standings, which lists in priority order the total points a school has accumulated after the highest and lowest votes are dropped.

The specific point values follow: 1st place = 40 points, 2nd = 37, 3rd = 35, 4th = 33, 5th = 31, 6th = 29, 7th = 27, 8th = 25, 9th = 23, 10th = 21, 11th = 19, 12th = 17, 13th = 15, 14th = 13, 15th = 11, 16th = 10, 17th = 9, 18th = 8, 19th = 7, 20th = 6, 21st = 5, 22nd = 4,

McKendree Bearcats Top DII/DIII February Poll

Nacogdoches, TX -- Perennial power McKendree once again finds itself atop the February poll of the National Ten Pin Coaches Association (NTCA).

The Bearcats tallied 550 poll points to easily outdistance second place Maryville (St. Louis). University of Wisconsin-Whitewater, came in third.

Rounding out the DII/DIII top 10 are Lewis University, Lincoln Memorial University, Adelphi University, University of Central University, Wilmington University, Marian University and Medaille College.

Voting is done by NCAA head coaches that are members of the NTCA with 27 ballots cast.
